Headquarters Lessons

Excerpt:

Before it is possible for you to function in any way as a part of a Center within the overall group life or within the body of humanity, you must have some understanding of what a center

system is, of the particular Center within which you are related, and of its particular service or function.

This Center which is being created now by the integrated relationships - the energy, force and substance which you are able to bring into focus and to reflect into outward appearance - actually corresponds to the cave in the center of the head, the center of synthesis. Consider what this means—the esoteric head center. Remember, so far within the organized group life on etheric levels, three centers have been created:

- 1. The Head Center, whose function is to bring into focus the integrated energy, force and substance of Divine Purpose, Divine Power, Divine Will, to establish and maintain the relation- ship with the overshadowing Spiritual Soul.
- The Heart Center, whose function is to bring into focus the integrated relationship of the energy, force and substance of Divine Love, Divine Wisdom, spiritual understanding, the in-breath and the out-breath of the conscious Soul incarnate, and to reflect these into outer appearance.
- 3. The Throat Center, whose function is to bring into focus the form aspect or the intelligent activity aspect, the substantial aspect of the Wisdom, that Divine Law and Order which is the brotherhood of man, to bring the integrated energy, force and substance into outer appearance.

These Centers have no relationship with one another or true meaning (insofar as the man in the brain is concerned, the conscious Soul incarnate); they cannot be utilized consciously, until the cave in the center of the head comes into function—until this Center of Synthesis and the consciousness focused within it can wield the energy, force and substance of these three esoteric Centers; can direct that energy, force and substance to a pre-determined destination and manifestation.

You will begin (if you will study this instruction) to approach a comprehension of the function of this Center. At a later date, more will be projected regarding this.

The lower centers have been developed and have become very active through the process of evolution. Each center not only focuses into the outer appearance—which you call or identify as the human entity—the energy, force and substance for which it is responsible, but also focuses a certain part of the consciousness of that individual.

For instance: the solar plexus center focuses into outer manifestation, through the instrumentality of the physical body - the animal soul.

The heart center focuses into outer manifestation - through the instrumentality of the astral body (called the higher aspirational body) - the human soul, that consciousness which is identified as and is limited or imprisoned within the confines of what we call the human soul. Each center focuses into activity, into expression (through some part of the instrument) a part of the consciousness of the total Soul, so that you see the total Soul as being composed of many states of identification.

There is that which is identified as the animal soul, which relates man to the animal kingdom; which gives him an animal body.

There is that which is the human soul, relating man with humanity and giving him his human nature and his aspirational qualities.

And there is that part of the consciousness which is related to God; which is identified as the Son; and which expresses—through the higher centers, to the mind—as the higher aspirational nature in the life and affairs of the disciple.

Between these three major states or foci of consciousness, there are others which partake of certain ones—for instance, in the solar plexus. Focused into activity through the solar plexus center (via the automatic response mechanism) is the subconscious, which has been created through the many, many experiences in many, many incarnations of the re-incarnated Soul.

A center, then, is responsible for a certain state of consciousness. It brings into focus and reflects outwardly into expression a certain state of consciousness and the energy—the integrated relationship of energy, force and substance—for which that specific state of conscious- ness is responsible. Thus, this Center is to bring into focus that state of consciousness which is identified as the disciple, the initiating disciple or the conscious Soul incarnate; to bring into focus the integrated relationship of energy, force and substance for which the disciple or the conscious Soul incarnate is responsible, this being—the energy, force and substance of the Divine Plan for humanity; the light, love and power of the Divine Plan for humanity; the Purpose, the Love, the understanding, the Wisdom and the Order, the intelligent activity, of the Divine Plan for humanity—and this integrated relationship, in a new Synthesis (as it is reflect- ed with specific happenings, specific events, specific needs) now, in this time and place.

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
